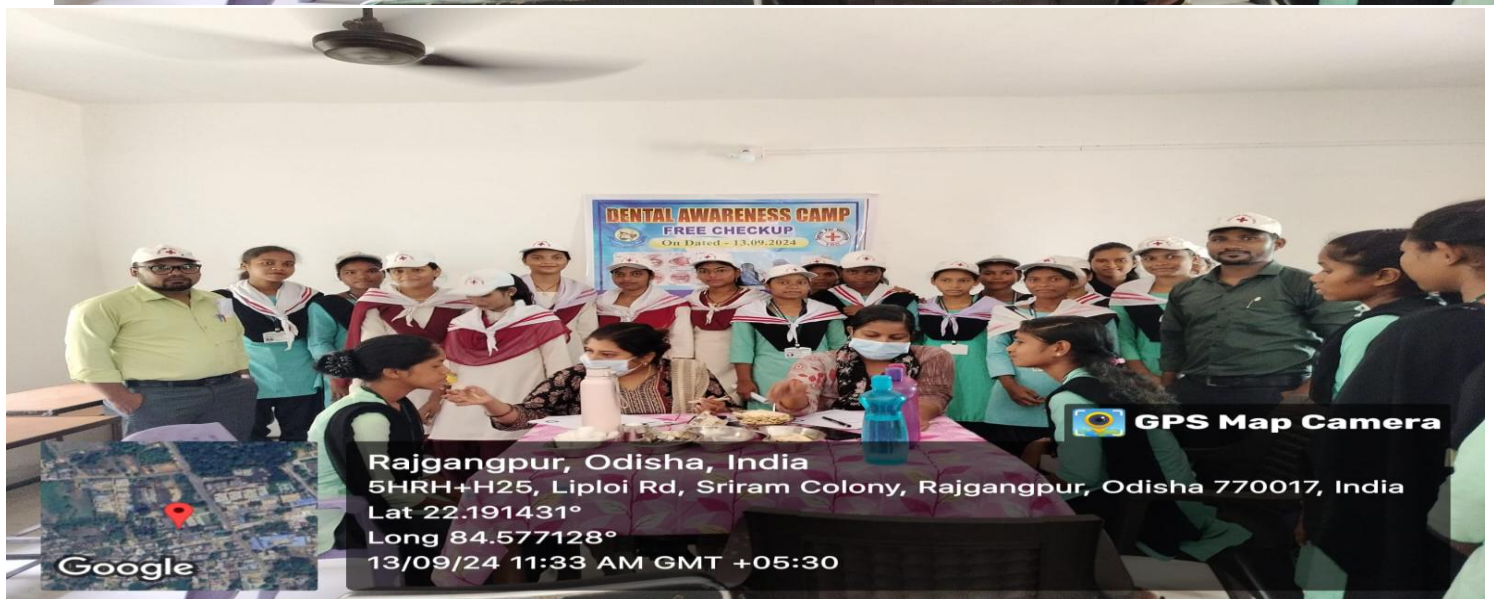
The collaborative effort of the YRC and NCC wings, along with active community involvement, made the campaign impactful and memorable.
