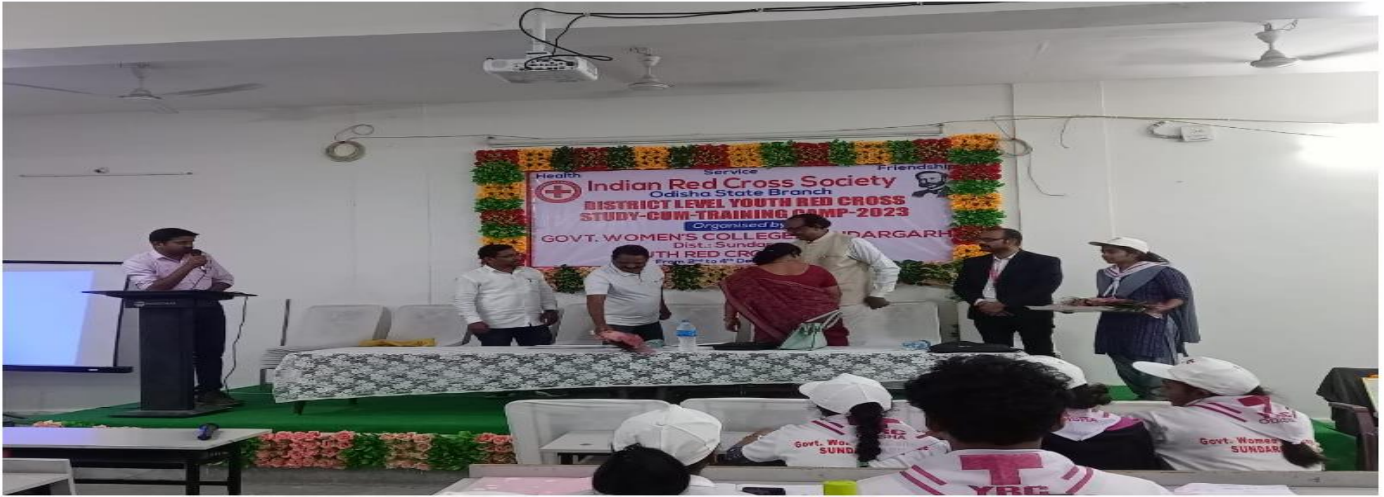

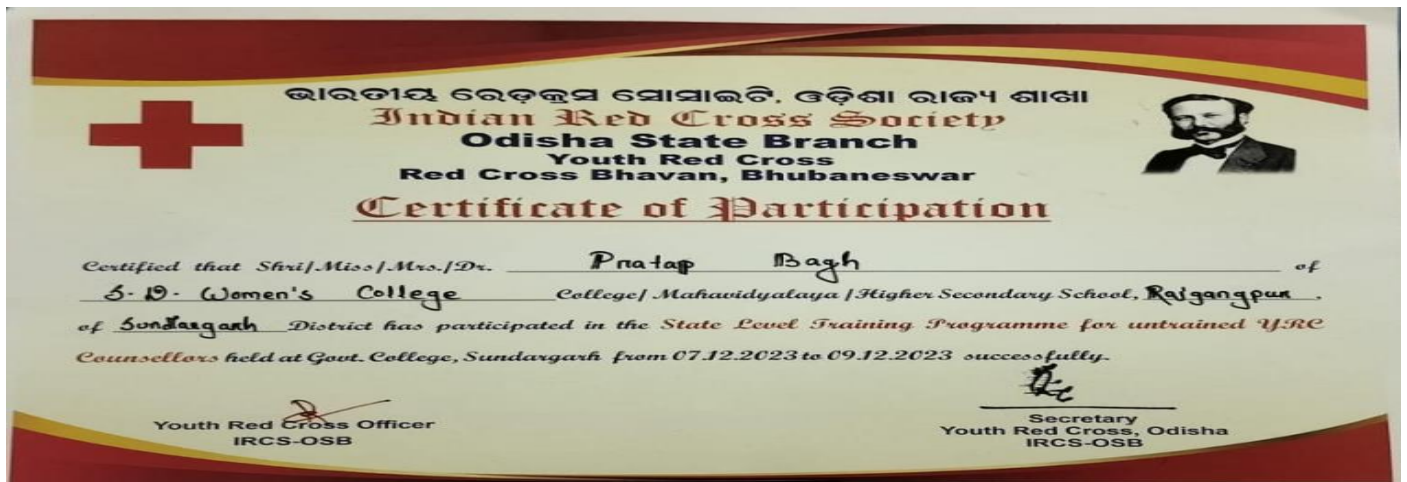

13.National youth day 2024.

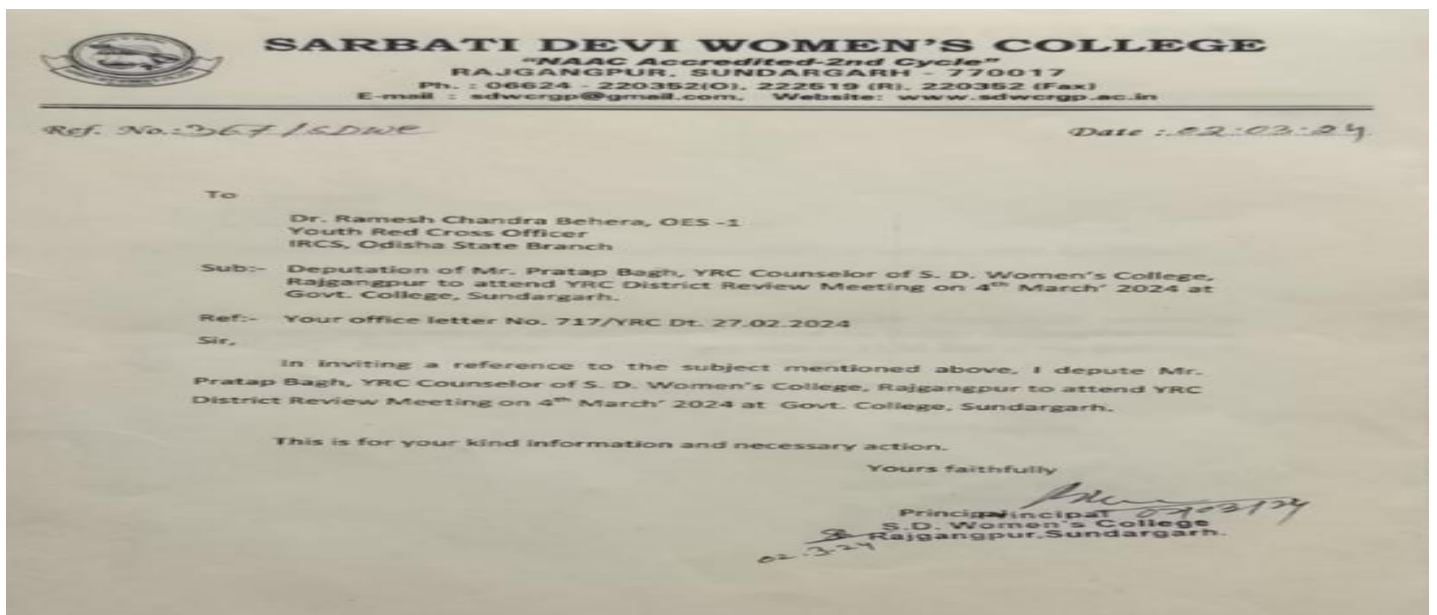
