

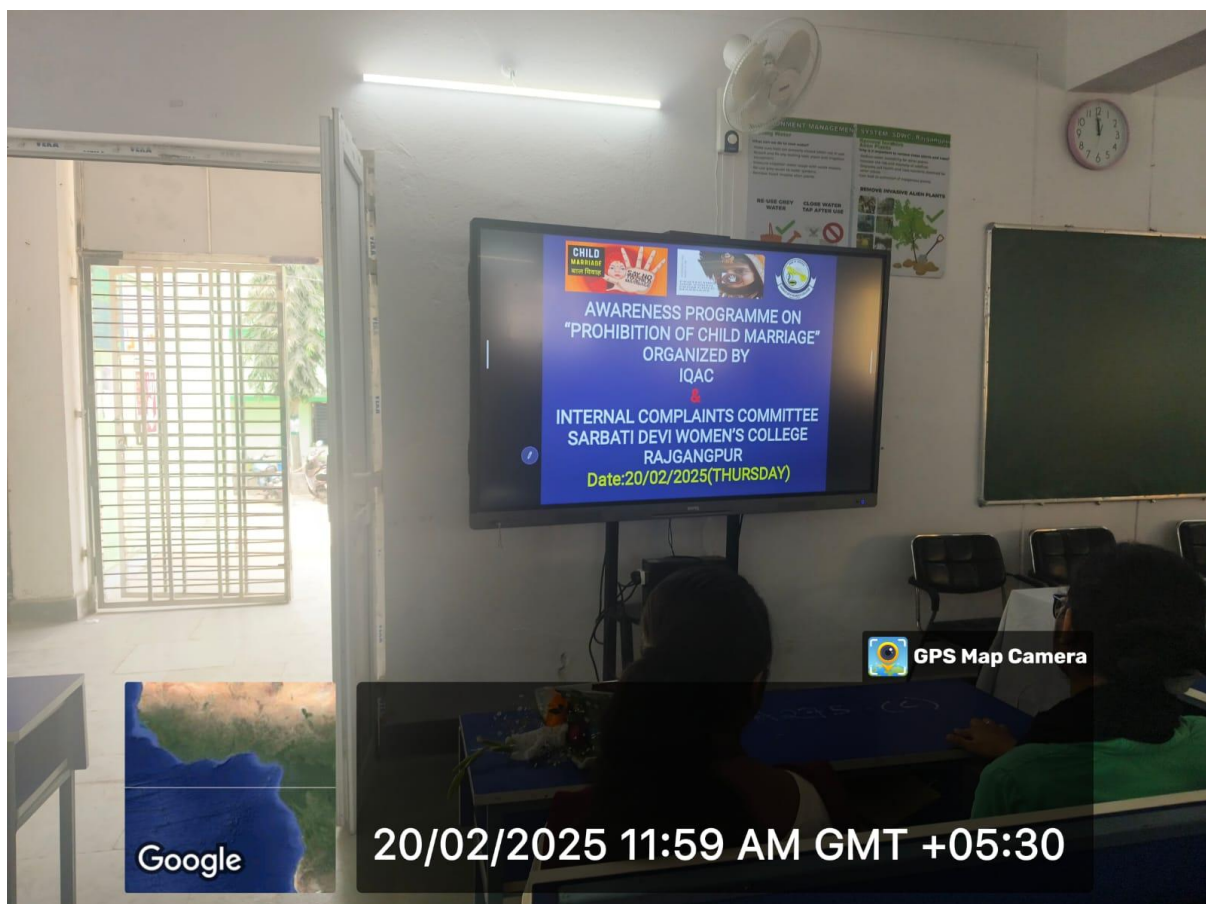
## CHILD MARRIAGE PREVENTION AWARENESS PROGRAMME
